Roland E. Munro Sr.

Roland E. Munro Sr., 73, of 204 W. Highland St., Avis, died Sunday, Dec. 9, 2007 at his home, surrounded by his family.

Born March 9, 1934 in Lock Haven, he was a son of J. Fred Munro and the former Anna Fox.

Roland is survived by his wife, the former Kay M. Johnstonbaugh. They were united in marriage July 15, 1951 in Jersey Shore.

He attended Lock Haven High School and worked at Johnstonbaugh's Dairy prior to joining the U.S. Air Force in 1952. He was discharged from the Air Force in 1956 and served another four years in the reserves. He then worked at Karnish Instruments and Crissman Meat Packing. In the late 1960s, he began working at Munro Farms with his brother until he retired in 1999. He continued to work part-time on the farm until the end of October of this year.



In addition to his wife, Roland is survived by a daughter, Marjorie A. Davis of Avis; three brothers, Edgar (Dorothy) Munro of Lock Haven, B. Dean (Mary) Munro of Jersey Shore and Alfred B. (Wanda) Munro of Jersey Shore; six grandchildren, Sean Munro, Corie Ann Pepka, Shayna Countryman, Edward Munro, Wade Munro, Benjamin Munro and Corie Ann Hurlbutt; and four great grandchildren, Brian Munro, Evan Munro, Elana Munro and Kaylee Major.

Roland was preceded in death by two sons, Roland E. Munro Jr. and Vaughn Munro; two brothers, Jonathan and Arnold; and a sister, Mildred Heimbach.

Memorial services will be Friday, Dec. 14, 2007 at 11 a.m. in Liberty United Methodist Church, Island Road, Lock Haven. The Rev. Dr. Ginger Baker-Betz, his pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in Swissdale Cemetery.
